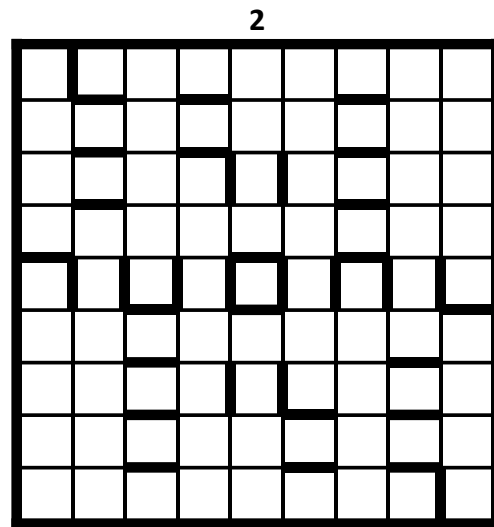
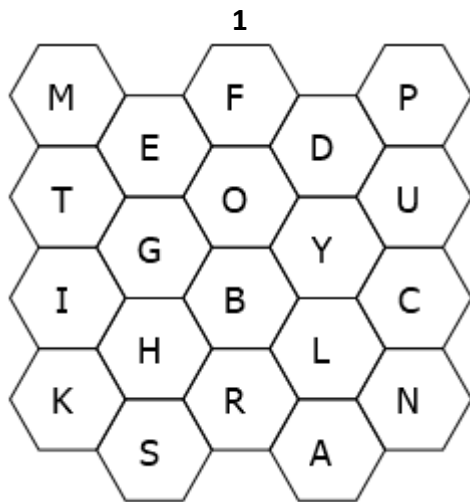


Dyno-Rod

The answers, each beginning with the stated letter, must be entered in grid 2. Every clue has a misprint in the wordplay which must be corrected before solving; the correct letter is to be entered alongside the clue label in grid 1 (eg for clue A next to the letter A), while the letters replaced spell a message. Solvers must complete both grids, highlighting 5 cells in grid 1, using an appropriate colour. The unchecked, unclued letters in grid 2 could spell "I 'AVE 'OPE".
